**Camille - Fostering Hope**

The Fostering Hope program originated in Seattle at First Free Methodist church. Over the years, the team’s work to holistically care for families, social workers, foster children, and youth has been changing the lives, the systems, and the culture of foster care in King County, Washington.

**Yvonne - Wunder’s Program**

Wunder’s equips girls and women to thrive around the world, helping girls stay in school through locally-made sustainable menstrual supplies and community-based education that emphasizes that we are all created in the image of God.



**Felicia - Set Free Monterey Bay**

Set Free Monterey Bay is a Christian organization established to assist adult women (ages 18 and over) sex trafficking survivors to find healing in a Christ-centered, restoration home and to educate the Monterey Bay community about human trafficking.

Our Filipino leader, Ken, works alongside her husband, Jemuel, to equip pastors and mobilize churches to be informed, compassionate responders to human trafficking.



**Mayra - Colombia**

Our Set Free team in Hungary strives to unite the abolitionist movement in Budapest and equip influencers of society to address human trafficking and abuse. Our leaders also serve people living at the margins who are vulnerable to exploitation, especially children in orphanages, people facing unemployment, and ethnic Roma groups.

The Canfield Set Free Team is working to build relationships within strip clubs to love on, care for, and educate the workers on human trafficking.



**Amber - MyPlace**

MyPlace reduces the vulnerability for exploitation by offering safe housing and holistic support services to youth and young adults in the Greater Jackson area with a preference to those in vulnerable circumstances.



**Girls in India**

In India, our leaders are raising critical awareness of human trafficking, equipping caregivers to protect their children and access resources, and fosters an abolitionist culture within Free Methodist churches in India. The team works with local partners to repatriate trafficked youth with families in their home communities.
