Over the past 11+ years the Set Free Movement's mission has been to not only fight human trafficking but to also create transformational impact in communitites. Teams around the world are working to create new futures, build community resilience, and reduce vulnerabilities to human trafficking.

- The SFM is incubating and accelerating additional ministries and independent organizations. In 2020 two new, independent ministries were launched out of our team and partnership processes: Set Free Monterey Bay in California and MyPlace in Michigan.
- This year we are expanding our work in Colombia, Hungary, several US States, as well as foster care support ministries. We are continue to partner strong with SEED Livelihood Network, International Child Care Ministries, as well as missionaries and national leaders.
- In 2021, we are hopeful. We are focused on identifying innovative ways and mobilizing communities to protect the vulnerable so the oppressed experience hope and healing as neighborhoods are transformed.

We pursue our vision and mission through integrated, holistic commitment to these core values:


- Being Christ Centered

We continue to invest spiritually, emotion ally, and financially in 11 international leaders, two of which are receiving master's degrees because of our support. In the U.S., we are helping multiple leaders facilitate change in their communities. Throughout the COVID-19 Pandemic we have been working hard to equip and support leaders.



EQUIPPED PEOPLE TO LIVE IN THE DIRECTION OF FREEDOM

In fall 2020, Set Free: A Guide To Pursuing Liberation in an Age of Bondage, an update to our book Urban Shalom, was published. An engaging book club emerged and people are meeting weekly to discuss how to use the Set Free book as a resource guide.

REPLICATED AND GREW MINISTRIES TO SUPPORT FREEDOM

We celebrated with the MyPlace team as they remodeled and prepared their home in Jackson, MI for residents, expected in early 2021. MyPlace, an independent, launched ministry of the Set Free Movement, is rental living space for youth aging out of foster care or that can be placed in Independent Living.



PARTNERED STRONG

We are proud to partner with SEED Livelihood Network and International Child Care Ministries on a developing project to help girls stay in school and equip a generation of leaders through sustainable women's health supplies and curriculum.



REGIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

The Set Free Movement is comprised of 35+ teams in our international impact network working to end slavery in their own communities.

United States

Teams are engaging in their community in innovative ways and deepening impact through strengthened and Spirit-led engagement. We are deepening our impact through strengthened engagement with foster families and youth.

In Seattle, we are shining the light of hope to foster kids and youth and to the foster parents and social workers who care for them.

We are leading the conversation on human trafficking prevention through community awareness events, thousands of youth are educated yearly. We are reaching out to the vulnerable and creating new futures in local communities.

Our team in Canfield, OH is connecting and serving in strip clubs. In the long term, this ministry will help to build relationships necessary to help women get out of the industry.

Latin America

In Colombia, the team is supporting and mentoring children and youth, letting them know they are loved and made in the image of God.



Our team in Spain is part of the Mosacio Center in Rivas Vaciamadrid, Spain and is hosting students for English courses.

We are preventing the exploitation of at-risk children and ethnic minorities in Hungary. The team is expanding into new communities throughout the country.

Partners in Bulgaria are nearly ready to receive residents at the St. John's Home. St. John's Home creates access to education, health care, and vocational training in a safe, spiritually rich, loving, family environment for Roma girls.

Asia:

SFM is educating communities on protecting children from abuse and reuniting families in India.

We are discipling and supporting female migrant workers in Taiwan.

We are excited to welcome Tanya Rosado to our team! Tanya will serve as the Regional Coordinator for Set Free Movement in Latin America. In this new role, she will connect and coach leaders

throughout the region.

Africa:

In Kenya, SFM partner organization THRIVE is educating and protecting young women from the vulnerability of gender based violence and human trafficking.




